### Good Morning!

This time of the year, we are accustomed to seeing graduates at all levels of education dressed out in a traditional cap and gown. But, why a cap and gown?

This was taken from the Herff Jones webpage: "Other formal gatherings generally call for a suit and tie, or a dress. So, what's with a cap and gown for graduation? The answer takes us back to the time when the first universities were being founded during the 12th and 13th centuries. Those universities were typically founded by the clergy and both the professors as well as the students wore gowns and hoods that signified a religious status."

There are other rituals and habits that become ingrained in our culture as "traditions." Oftentimes, the origin and purpose of a tradition becomes far less important that the tradition itself. When it comes to the Church, there is always the danger that our traditions can overrule biblical authority. That happened, in a sense, with the Jews and the Law. Jesus admonished the Pharisees, "You search the Scriptures [Law] because you think that in these you have eternal life. But, it is these that tell of Me" (John 5:39).

My charge to these graduates is – Keep the main thing the main thing. "Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you" (Matthew 6:33). Don't let the traditions and societal "norms" ever get in the way of your walk with the Lord, and the authority of His word.
